



# 2019 Angelman Series Notice of Race

February 9, March 2, April 6

## 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club (BCYC) is the organizing authority for the Angelman Series.

## 2. RULES

- 2.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, (*RRS*), the rules of the Performance Handicap Racing Fleet of Southern California (PHRF), and the Notice of Race, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2 The Regatta is classified as a Category "A" Event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- 2.3 Boats are subject to inspection by the appropriate fleet coordinator to ensure conformity to the applicable class rules, bylaws and/or measurement certificates.
- 2.4 *RRS* 55 is changed by adding the following sentence to the rule: "However, discarding elastic or wool bands when setting a sail is permitted."
- 2.5 The current US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (USSER) shall apply.

## 3. CLASSES

The fleet will be divided into appropriate classes based on the PHRF Area D Random Leg Course Ratings.

## 4. ELIGIBILITY

Each entrant must be a member of PHRF of Southern California and have a valid rating certificate, and be a member of an SCYA Member Yacht Club or a USSA recognized yacht club if not a resident of Area J.

## 5. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$36.

## 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available one (1) week prior to the first race at the BCYC Office, and on the internet at [www.bcy.org](http://www.bcy.org).

**7. SCHEDULE**

- 7.1 The races are scheduled to be sailed on February 9, March 2, and April 6
- 7.2 Any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1900 hours on the day before the race on the Race Bulletin Board at BCYC and on-line at [www.bcy.org](http://www.bcy.org).
- 7.3 The first warning signal is scheduled for 1255 hours.

**8. COURSES TO BE SAILED**

- 8.1 Random Leg courses and Modified Windward/Leeward courses will be sailed.
- 8.2 The Start/Finish Line will be in the vicinity of the Newport Pier.

**9. PENALTIES**

*RRS 44.1 and RRS 44.2 apply.*

**10. SCORING**

- 10.1 Scoring for daily races and Class Overall will be based on *RRS A4*.
- 10.2 Scoring for the Angelman Series Best Overall will be according to the Rinderle B table (located on the BCYC web-site)
- 10.3 There are no throwouts. This changes *RRS A2*.
- 10.4 *RRS A9* does not apply
- 10.5 A boat that did not start, did not finish, was disqualified or retired, shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of **starters** in the race. This modifies *RRS A4.2*.

**11. PRIZES**

- 11.1 Take Home Trophies will be given out after each day of racing.
- 11.2 Trophies for the Series will be given out after the last race.
