



WILD SAILING REGATTA
September 14, October 5, November 23, 2019
NOTICE OF RACE

1. GENERAL

Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club (BCYC) is the organizing authority.

2. RULES

- 2.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (*RRS*), the rules of the Performance Handicap Racing Fleet of Southern California (PHRF) and the Notice of Race, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2 The Regatta is classified as a Category "A" Event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- 2.3 Boats are subject to inspection by the appropriate fleet coordinator to ensure conformity to the applicable class rules, bylaws and/or measurement certificates.
- 2.4 *RRS* 55 is changed by adding the following sentence to the rule: "However, discarding elastic or wool bands when setting a sail is permitted."
- 2.5 US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (USSER) for Near Shore apply.
- 2.6 Spinnakers shall not be flown inside the harbor.
- 2.7 Mooring fields and anchorage areas in Newport harbor are considered obstructions and shall not be entered.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 The Regatta is open to:
 - 3.1.1 Boats with a current PHRF Rating Certificate and LOA less than 50 feet
 - 3.1.2 Boats without a PHRF Rating Certificate and LOA less than 50 feet – a rating may be assigned by the Organizing Authority.

4. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$45.

5. CLASSES

- 5.1 PHRF entries will be assigned to classes based on their Area D RLC rating or in a class deemed appropriate by Race Committee.
- 5.2 Entries with a rating assigned by Race Committee will be placed in an appropriate class.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available no later than one (1) week prior to the race at the BCYC Office, and on the internet at www.bcy.org.

7. SCHEDULE

The first warning signal each race day is scheduled for 1300 hours.

8. COURSES TO BE SAILED

Random Leg Courses will start inside Newport harbor, sail around marks in the ocean, and finish inside Newport harbor.

9. PENALTIES

RRS 44.1 is changed to a One-Turn Penalty.

10. SCORING

10.1 Each race day, a boat's Daily Score will be her finishing position after scoring all races that day.

10.2 A boat's Series Score will be the sum of her Daily Scores less any discarded scores.

10.3 There are no throw out Daily Scores. This changes *RRS* A2.1

10.4 A boat that did not start/compete, did not finish, is disqualified, or retires, shall be scored points for the finishing place **one more** than the number of **starters** in the race. This changes *RRS* A4.2 and A9

11. PRIZES

11.1 Daily trophies will be given out after racing.

11.2 Series trophies will be given out after the last race of the Series.
