



2020-2021 Hot Rum Series Notice of Race

1 RULES

- The Regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (*RRS*), the Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- While racing, boats shall not enter the mooring or anchorage areas. These areas are defined as obstructions.
- Double headsails are allowed but are limited in size to the largest sail reported on the PHRF Rating Certificate.
- Spinnakers are **not** allowed. This changes *RRS* 50.
- Headsails may be jibs/genoas as permitted by class rules, but in no case larger than 155%.
- Jibs/genoas may be used with one whisker/spinnaker pole if class rules permit doing so.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- Boats less than 50 feet LOA may compete.
- BCYC reserves the right to move a boat to a class that is deemed appropriate.
- Any PHRF boat that has its rating changed after having submitted an Entry shall provide BCYC with its new Rating prior to noon on race day. The boat will continue to race in its originally assigned class at its new Rating

3. SCHEDULE

- Dates & Times
 - Sunday, November 1, 2020 Race #1 & #2
 - Sunday, December 13, 2020 Race #3 & #4
 - Sunday, January 17, 2021 Race #5 & #6
 - First warning each day at 1200 hours
- Number of races
 - Six (6) races (2 per race day) are scheduled.

4. ENTRIES and FEES

- Entries will be accepted until 1700 hours on the day before the first race.
- The Series entry fee is \$36.00.

5. ENTRY FORM

The Entry Form is available on-line at www.bcy.org.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at BCYC and on the BCYC website no later than 1700 hours on the Friday before the first race.

7. COURSES

- Random Leg courses will be sailed.
- One or more marks shown on Attachment #1 will be rounded during each race.

8. SCORING

- Each race day, a boat's Daily Score will be her finishing position after scoring all races that day.
- A boat's Series Score will be the sum of her Daily Scores.
- Scoring will be based on the boat's Area D Random Leg Rating PLUS its Non-Spinnaker Offset.
- Three (3) races constitute a Series
- There are no throwouts. This changes *RRS A2*
- *RRS A9* shall not apply.
- A boat that did not start, did not finish, was disqualified, or retired, shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of starters in the race. This modifies *RRS A4.2* and *A9*
- PHRF boats will be scored using the boat's Area D RLC Rating PLUS its Non-Spinnaker Offset.

9. PENALTY

- *RRS 44.1* is changed to a One-Turn Penalty

10. PRIZES

- Awards will be given out after each day of racing.
- Trophies for the series will be awarded after the last race.
