### NOTICE OF RACE AMENDMENT #1

The Sections highlighted in yellow have been amended

#### 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club (BCYC) is the organizing authority.

#### 2. RULES

- 2.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (*RRS*), the rules of the fleet in which the boat races, and the Notice of Race, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2 The Regatta is classified as a Category "A" Event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- 2.3 Boats are subject to inspection by the appropriate fleet coordinator to ensure conformity to the applicable class rules, bylaws and/or measurement certificates.
- 2.4 The current US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (USSER) for Near Shore apply.
- 2.5 USSER 2.4.1 shall also apply. A boat's deck including the headstay shall be surrounded by a suitably strong enclosure, typically consisting of lifelines and pulpits, meeting the requirements in USSER 2.4.2 to 2.4.8.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 PHRF - Each PHRF entrant must have a current, valid PHRF rating.
- 3.2 ORCA – Each ORCA entrant must have a current, valid ORCA rating.

#### 4. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$45.

#### 5. CLASSES

- 5.1 PHRF entries will be assigned to classes based on their Area D RLC rating
- 5.2 ORCA entries will be assigned to an ORCA-only class.

5.3 A minimum of three (3) boats is required to constitute a class.

5.4 ALL-WOMEN CREW boats will race in a PHRF class only and will also be scored against each other.

## 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available no later than one (1) week prior to the race at the BCYC Office, and on the internet at [www.bcy.org](http://www.bcy.org).

## 7. SCHEDULE

The first warning signal each day is scheduled for 1055 hours.

## 8. COURSE TO BE SAILED

8.1 Start, round Oil Island Edith to port - pass Oil Island Ellen-Elly to port - round Oil Island Eureka to port - Finish

8.2 The Start line will be located off the Santa Ana River jetty (approximate GPS coordinates of 33.37.153 N and 117.57.395 W)

8.3 The Finish will be located in the vicinity of Newport Pier (approximate GPS coordinates of N 33° 36.500' and W 117° 56.250').

8.4 The handicap distance is 21.09 nm.

## 9. PENALTIES

*RRS* 44.1 is changed to a One-Turn penalty.

## 10. SCORING

10.1 Daily scoring will be according to *RRS* A4.1 Low Point System.

10.2 Area D RLC Ratings will be used for scoring for PHRF boats.

10.3 ORCA Ratings will be used for scoring ORCA boats

10.4 Each race day, a boat's Daily Score will be her finishing position.

10.5 For Best in Class Series scoring, a boat's Series Score will be the sum of her Daily Scores.

10.6 For Best Overall Series scoring, a boat's Series Score will be the sum of her Daily Scores which have been assigned Points from the Rinderle B table. The boat with the Highest Point Total will be awarded Best Overall.

10.7 There are no throw out Daily Scores. This changes *RRS* A2.1

10.8 A boat that did not start/compete, did not finish, is disqualified, or retires, shall be scored points for the finishing place **one more** than the number of **starters** in the race. This changes *RRS* A5.2.

## 11. PRIZES

11.1 Take-home prizes will be given out after each day of racing.

11.2 The Perpetual trophies shown below will be awarded after the last day of racing.
