



2022 Hot Rum Series Notice of Race

November 13 & December 11

The organizing authority is Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club (BCYC), 1601 Bayside Drive, Corona Del Mar, CA 92625, (949) 644-9530

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (*RRS*), the Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 While racing, boats shall not enter the mooring or anchorage areas. These areas are defined as obstructions.
- 1.3 Double headsails are allowed but are limited in size to the largest sail reported on the PHRF Rating Certificate.
- 1.4 Spinnakers are **not** allowed.
- 1.5 Jibs/genoas may be used with one whisker/spinnaker pole if class rules permit doing so.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Boats less than 50 feet LOA are invited to race.
- 2.2 PHRF-rated boats are invited to race
- 2.3 Harbor 20's are invited to race.
- 2.4 Boats without a PHRF rating may race subject to prior approval by Race Committee and will be assigned a "Race Rating" by Race Committee.
- 2.5 Race Committee may assign a boat to a class that is deemed appropriate by Race Committee.
- 2.6 Any PHRF boat that has its rating changed after having submitted an Entry shall provide BCYC with its new Rating prior to noon on race day. The boat will continue to race in its originally assigned class at its new Rating.

3. SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Dates & Times
 - Sunday, November 13, 2022 Races #1 & #2
 - Sunday, December 11, 2022 Races #3 & #4
- 3.2 Number of Races
 - Four (4) races (2 per race day) are scheduled

4. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$30.00.

5. ENTRY FORM

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available on-line at [Hot Rum Series – BCYC Racing](#) no later than 1700 hours on the day before the first race.

7. COURSES

- 7.1 Random Leg courses will be sailed.
- 7.2 Marks are shown on Attachment #1.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 Each race day, a boat's Daily Score will be the sum of her finishing positions after scoring all races that day.
- 8.2 A boat's Series Score will be the sum of her Daily Scores.
- 8.3 Two (2) races constitute a Series
- 8.4 There are no throwouts. This changes *RRS A2.1*
- 8.5 A boat that did not start, did not finish, was disqualified, or retired, shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of starters in the race. This modifies *RRS A5.2*
- 8.6 PHRF boats will be scored using the boat's Area D RLC Rating PLUS its Non-Spinnaker Offset.

9. PENALTY

RRS 44.1 is changed to a One-Turn Penalty

10. PRIZES

- 10.1 Awards will be given out after each day of racing.
- 10.2 Trophies for the series will be awarded after the last race.
