Notice of Race

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club (BCYC) is the organizing authority for the Bogart Race.

2. RULES

2.1 The Race will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, (*RRS*), the rules of the Performance Handicap Racing Fleet of Southern California (PHRF), the Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2.2 US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (USSER) apply.

3. CLASSES AND RATINGS

3.1 Boats will be placed into classes based on their **REGIONAL Random Leg Rating and scored using the REGIONAL Random Leg Rating**

3.2 Race Committee may assign a boat to a class it deems appropriate.

4. ELIGIBILITY

Boats must have a current, valid PHRF Rating Certificate.

5. ENTRY FEE

5.1 The entry fee for the race on Saturday only is \$25

5.2 The entry fee for racing both Saturday and Sunday is \$45

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available not later than one (1) week prior to the first race at the BCYC Office, and on the BCYC website at www.bcy.org.

7. SCHEDULE AND COURSES

7.1 Any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1900 hours on the day before the race on the BCYC website (www.bcy.org).

7.2 The first warning signal each day is scheduled for **1155** hours.

7.3 The courses are:

7.3.1 SATURDAY – Start, Pass through Queen’s Gate in Long Beach, Finish at Long Beach mark #38. Handicap distance is **19.0** miles

7.3.2 SUNDAY – Start at Mark #38, Pass through Queen’s Gate, Finish.
Handicap distance is 19.0 miles.

7.3.3 The Start/Finish line in Newport Beach is located at approximate GPS coordinates of 33°36'36.73"N and 117°56'20.46"W

7.3.4 Mark #38 in Long Beach is located at approximate GPS coordinates of 33°44'6.42"N and 118° 8'6.30"W

8. PENALTIES

RRS 44.1 is changed to be a One-Turn Penalty.

9. SCORING

9.1 Scoring will be according to the Rinderle B High-Point method for each day’s race.

9.2 Scoring for the Series will be based on the sum of each day’s points.

9.3 There are no throw-outs. This changes *RRS* A2.1

10. PRIZES

10.1 Prizes will be awarded in Long Beach for the race from Newport Beach to Long Beach

10.2 Prizes will be awarded at Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club for the race from Long Beach to Newport Beach

10.3 Series prizes will be awarded at Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club for the combined scoring of the race from Newport Beach to Long Beach AND the race from Long Beach to Newport Beach.
